**The Directive 2002/95/EC** of the European Parliament and of the council on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).

The RoHS Directive aims to limit the use of certain substances commonly used in designing electrical and electronic equipment.

**The Directive 2002/96/EC** of the European Parliament and of the council on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE).

The WEEE Directive aims to improve the level of recycling of electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) and encourages designers to develop products with recycling efficiency in mind.
